
ENVISIONS SAFE AND SECURE HOMES FOR THE DEPRIVED











Aji Krishnan which overcame all odds and kept the society functioning and vibrant for two decades. I had the privilege of taking over the Presidentship of this Organization in 2014. I have a track record of 17 years as an IAS officer in Kerala, three-time Lok Sabha MP from Kollam, Kerala and a Union Minister for a decade. Thus, I had the opportunity to play a leadership role in several iconic projects in Health & Family Welfare, Textiles, Information & Broadcasting, Defense, Petroleum, Non-Conventional Energy, Agriculture, Fisheries, Small Scales Industries etc. across the whole spectrum of socio-economic development in Kerala State and the rest in the country. As President of HRDS, I am committed to bring my entire experience and network to make this NGO a front running Social Service Organization in India especially in the field of Tribal Welfare. In this effort I am ably supported by a highly professional team of social workers, professionals, scientists and technocrats. We have launched the following major programmes for the coming decade. A Tribal Housing Project which is named as "Sadhgraha", for the homeless Tribal people all over India. We have already started this project in Wayanad, Palakkad, Idukki and Kottayam Districts of Kerala and also in Tripura, Gujarat, Jharkhand and Assam States. Our ambitious target is 1 million houses for the Tribal people in the next decade the biggest such programmes ever implemented in the country. Along with the housing project we have launched a massive Medicinal Plant Cultivation Program in Tribal Lands. We are helping the tribes to raise prescribed medicinal plants and sell the products to Ayurveda Companies for their raw material requirements. **Eminent** agricultural scientists

supervise the program. The Tribal farmer will get 60% of the profit from the venture and remaining 40% for further development including replanting. We are extending the project all over India under the title 'The Karshaka - Niramaya'. We are also doing some projects in Ghana, West Africa. I request, on behalf of HRDS INDIA all well-meaning Indians to support and bless us in our endeavors and make an outstanding success of our epic projects which can make a signal difference to the livelihoods of the most disadvantaged sections of our society.

SADHGRAHA The Project in a Nutshell


