










Donate One Brick, Build Up the Tribe's Life Empowering Millions Through Sustainable Housing



Empowering Rural India's Youth: DDU-GKY & Yuvakeralam



DDU-GKY (Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana) and Yuvakeralam are trailblazing initiatives with a singular focus: empowering rural youth from economically disadvantaged backgrounds, aged 15-35. Aligned with the Skill India Mission, these programs play a pivotal role in bolstering the government's socio-economic agenda, encompassing transformative initiatives like Make in India, Digital India, Smart Cities, and Startup India.

Our mission is to orchestrate the metamorphosis of rural youth into an economically self-sufficient and globally competitive workforce by leveraging the power of central government grants and meticulously crafted skilling initiatives.









Ekagrah Project: Fostering Educational Equity for Underprivileged Children

HRDS INDIA's pioneering Ekagrah Project, established in 2009, tackles the critical issue of educational disparity faced by economically disadvantaged children. 
The project has since strategically expanded to encompass the distribution of comprehensive educational kits in remote schools. Through support from government bodies, ministries, and corporations committed to social responsibility such as Indian Oil Corporation Ltd., HRDS INDIA equips these schools with essential learning materials. The program has embraced technological advancements, with the first phase witnessing the distribution of electronically loaded tablets, brimming with a wealth of educational content, to institutions like JNV, Alleppey.











However, HRDS INDIA has also identified a critical challenge in several states: a significant number of tribal students, even after completing their education, struggle with fundamental literacy skills – the ability to read and write basic words and sentences. This issue extends to students pursuing their SSLC qualification. Our observations revealed a strong preference among these students to communicate in their native languages, often leading to difficulties in comprehending lessons delivered in a common language. Teachers, recognizing this language barrier, often resort to employing colloquial tribal languages to bridge the communication gap.

To dismantle these language barriers and dismantle the shackles of social disadvantage, HRDS INDIA has undertaken a strategic initiative. We have established a robust foundation through targeted workshops designed to inspire and motivate tribal children. These workshops place a strong emphasis on honing their analytical and computational thinking skills, equipping them with the tools they need to excel in their academic pursuits.














Cultivating a Sustainable Future: The Karshaka Project

Going beyond mere protection, HRDS INDIA has designed an income-generating program called BMCU (Bulk Milk Colling Unit). This program empowers women in villages by distributing cows along with comprehensive training and essential equipment for their care. HRDS INDIA's strategically located collection centers act as a vital channel, connecting villages to the BMCU. This initiative specifically targets tribal communities and the economically underprivileged to help them achieve financial stability.

AAGNEYA - NON-CONVENTIONAL ENERGY PROJECT "Keep the Biodiversity Colourful"

Biogas energy can play an important role in India's energy transition, ensuring energy security and affordability, enhancing entrepreneurship, providing rural employment, and boosting local economies. HRDS INDIA is implementing the first phase of this project with 534 acres of land in Trichy Tamilnadu State. The Aagneya project primarily focuses on manufacturing compressed biogas for Industrial purposes that counter environmental problems, aiming to support energy generation from, agricultural waste, plant residue, food waste and other non-conventional or renewable sources. The use of Biogas as automotive fuel is a significant step forward in generating replenishable power resources for the farmers of India.

Biogas generation using organic waste is a viable alternative, a highly durable source of income for the farming population. We would also be forming clusters for farmers by incorporating their participation for the smooth and proper









functioning of this project which would also be an upliftment for the living standards of farmers. We help these peasants with technical and mechanical support. Napier grass production and plant management inclusive of animal husbandry would secure a long-term income source for 5000 agriculture dependent families.




